Bioenergy Promotion 2 - From Strategies to Activities aims to strengthen the development towards a sustainable, competitive and territorially integrated Baltic Sea Region by promoting sustainable production and use of bioenergy.

Bioenergy Promotion 2 continues the work started during the Main Stage of the project. The objective is to extend the strategic outputs of the main stage project into the Baltic Sea Region and national political arenas including also local and regional administration and utility companies.

The two-year project (2012-2014) involves 13 partners from 8 countries in the region and has a total budget of EUR 1.5 million €. The project will serve as a central Baltic Sea Region-wide platform for cross-sectorial and transnational networking within bioenergy and related fields.

The project has been selected as a Flagship project in the Action Plan accompanying the European Union Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region. The Bioenergy Promotion 2 project is also a Baltic21 Lighthouse project.
